The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having heard from the driver and team representative and having examined video and telemetry evidence, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact Collided with the rear of car 17 at turn 14.
Offence Involved in an incident as defined by Article 16.1 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations

Decision

Penalty of a drop of 10 grid positions at the driver's next Event.

Reason

The driver admitted the collision was his error due to the failure to anticipate the braking performance of the car with lower tyre grip following a safety car period.
The penalty takes into account that this is the second similar offence by the driver this season.
