The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, and having heard from the drivers and team representatives and examined the video and telemetry evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following

**No/Driver** 1 Sebastian Vettel

**Competitor** Red Bull Racing

**Time** 21:22

**Session** Race

**Facts** Car 1 was alleged to have been driven erratically at Turn 16 at the end of the Safety Car period.

Alleged Breach of Article 40.5 of the FIA Formula One Sporting Regulations

**Decision**

No further action.

**Reason**

An examination of the telemetry overlay for throttle, steering and brake traces of both cars did not indicate any erratic driving behaviour on the part of the race leader.

It is noted that Article 40.13 provides that the first car may dictate the pace.
